# Tasting Notes from the Brew Monkey (Update 1/5/12)

**Ale Industries - Orange Shush (4.4%)** A fast growing, local favorite Belgian Wit brewed with real orange peel, coriander, and chamomile.

**Ale Industries - Uncle Jesse's Pale Ale (5.3%)** Hop forward Nor Cal Pale. Honey malt balanced with Columbus/Centennial Hops.

**Anchor Brewing - East Bay IPA (7.75%)** 100 IBUs and a simple malt profile really show off this IPA's character and Northern California heritage. Citra and Galaxy hops were used to dry hop this beer into next week!

**Anderson Valley - Winter Solstice (6.9%)** Creamy and smooth, with a medium sweetness. With hints of nutmeg and other spices this beer evokes memories of crackling fires and turkey dinners.

**Black Diamond - Harvest IBA (7.0%)** Dark mahogany beer with grapefruit and light caramel flavor. Think Black IPA.

**Black Diamond - Grand Cru Bourbon (8.0)** Traditional Abbey Double. Sweet caramel, dark fruit with bourbon and oak notes.

**Black Diamond - Rampage (9.0%)** A massive brew that is enormously aromatic with huge hop flavors wonderfully structured with a great malt body. The flavor comes on with huge notes of citrus, pine and resin which last into the crisp dry finish.

**Full Sail - Wreck the Halls (6.5%)** Think Christmas IPA. Nice hop profile from the dry hopping makes this is a nice ode to the season that's a little different from most spiced examples.

**Heretic Brewing - Evil Twin (6.8%)** Evil Twin has a rich malt character, without being overly sweet. It has a huge hop character, without being overly bitter.

**Heretic Brewing - Evil Cousin (8.0%)** A West Coast Imperial IPA. The hop character in this beer is intentionally on the dank side; big, sticky, and aggressive.

**Knee Deep - Beautiful Blond (4.2%)** Almost "Kolsch" like this is the one to go for if you are looking for something lighter on the palate.

**Knee Deep - Imperial Tanilla (10.0%)** Knee Deep's regular Tanilla is a wonderful Vanilla Porter. This is just a bigger, badder version of the same.

**Knee Deep - Rydentity Crisis (8.0%)** Rydentity Crisis is a medium-bodied, unfiltered, rye Belgian saison. It's slightly sweet flavor is balanced by it's fruity aroma and moderate tartness.

**Lagunitas - New Dog Town Pale (6.2%)** A West Coast APA. Smell citrus and pine. This is bold for a pale ale.

**Linden Street - Burning Oak Black Lager (5.5%)** Brewed as a German-style schwarzbier, this beer is dark but still crisp and refreshing. The name says it all, slight burnt, woody flavors.

**Linden Street - Urban People's Common Lager (5.4%)** Crisp refreshing Cal Common from our friends over the hill.

**Lost Coast - Raspberry Brown (6.5%)** Chocolate malt backbone with raspberry flavor. Dessert, yeah!

**Lost Coast - Tangerine Wheat (5.0%)** The ultimate in refreshing beers. Light but citrusy, with just a slight tartness. This cult classic is a must try.

**North Coast - Rasputin's Russian Imperial Stout (9.0%)** A style originally brewed for export to the Tsar of Russia, this beer is deep and complex with a strong malt backbone and great winter alcohol tummy warm.

**North Coast - Red Seal Ale (5.5%)** A classic west coast amber ale highlighted with Centennial hops.

**Smaltz - Coney Island Lager (5.5%)** An American Red Lager this is a interesting take on a lager. Look for biscuits balanced with hops and a nice lager crispness.

**Stone Brewing - Double Bastard (10.5%)** As if one bastard weren't enough...this is an intensely obnoxious beer from Stone. Don't even bother ordering it because you probably can't afford or handle this beer.

**Ace - Pear Cider (5.0%)** A pear cider with Madagascar vanilla. This is light on the palate with sour notes.

**Fox Barrel - Blackberry Cider (5.0%)** A wonderful pear/blackberry cider. Blackberry dark fruit taste with a sweet tang.

**Two River's - Irish Cider (5.0%)** Heavier apple based cider designed to make the perfect snakebite. Slightly sweet.
